TRAINING DETAILS

Reasonable Suspicion Determination Training (USDOT-FTA) (8:30 am - 12:30 pm)

This class satisfies the U.S. Department of Transportation training requirement for supervisor per 49 CFR Part 655.14(b)(2). Supervisory personnel must be trained in making the determination of when to administer reasonable suspicion drug and alcohol tests while managing employees with safety sensitive job functions. Seminar participants will learn to identify the signs and symptoms and physical behavioral, speech and performance indicators of probable drug use and alcohol misuse, and to make fair and reliable reasonable suspicion drug and alcohol testing referrals of transit employees performing safety-sensitive functions. Certificates of completion will be mailed to participants.

Prescription/Over-the-County Medications Policy – Best Practices (1:30 pm – 4:30 pm)

In a society where billions of prescriptions are filled each year, and millions spent on over-the-counter medications, the concern for how prescription and over-the-counter (Rx/OTC) medication use not only impacts transit system safety, but also how transit systems are responding to this safety risk remains a topic of national attention, especially in light of recent transportation accidents involving Rx/OTC medication use. This session will continue the discussion of how transit systems are meeting this very real safety issue within their overall drug and alcohol programs and present best practices and tips for writing an internal policy that is both reasonable and realistic.
