This course will include an introduction to the principles and 4 key pillars of a Safety Management System (SMS): Policy, risk, assurance and promotion. Building upon traditional transit system safety, participants will learn about the SMS framework which includes executive leadership and accountability for safety, creating a positive safety culture, preventive risk analysis and building an employee non-punitive safety reporting program. At the end of this course, participants will have a great awareness of crucial safety practices which are available through SMS integration with transit system safety; including practical applications and exercises to begin SMS implementation.
